A 40-year-old man presented with complaints of multiple joint pain for 6 years predominantly involving the hip joints with difficulty in squatting and sitting cross-legged. There was also history of morning stiffness with waxing and waning of symptoms. On examination, there was anterior hip joint tenderness and bilateral restriction of movements of hip joints with a 2 cm supratrochanteric shortening on left side and 1 cm on the right side. The biochemical and haematological examinations were within normal limits. On radiological examination there was irregular destruction of the femoral heads with acetabular erosions. Microscopic examination of the synovium showed peculiar pathology.comment
